

Martin University Student Requirements for Scholarship Application Submission

Student Requirements

- 1. File FAFSA by or before April 15th every year. (Federal School Code: 014975)
- 2. Complete the general scholarship application online.
- **3.** Submit a one-page (500 words) essay, typed in Times New Roman 12 pt. font and double-spaced. Choose from one of the following topics:
 - The importance of education.
 - How will you benefit from this scholarship?
 - What are your educational goals?
- 4. Use the following cover page format for your scholarship essay.

- 5. Submit your essay to the Financial Aid Office or online. Your application and essay will be reviewed and, if necessary, your essay will be returned to you for any grammatical adjustments needed.
- 6. The Scholarship Committee will review all applicant materials. Applicants selected as a scholarship recipient will be notified via their Martin University student email.
- 7. Submit all application materials (completed application and essay with cover page) before the deadline date.

SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES: FALL- AUGUST 1 SPRING- JANUARY 5 SUMMER- JUNE 1

Other helpful Information

- > You must be a currently enrolled student at least half-time (6 hrs.) and meet SAP standards.
- Financial aid awards may be adjusted based on other aid received, including scholarships, state aid, veteran's benefits, employer pay, etc.
- Scholarships are non-refundable. Options for using scholarship funds for prior balances will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- If you drop below half-time enrollment, or fail to attend your classes, you will forfeit your scholarship award.
- > Incomplete scholarship applications or scholarships submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
- > Submission of scholarship materials does not guarantee an award.
